Re: Sealing of Hopkins St, Aireys Inlet (Great Ocean Rd to Hartley St).

We attach a petition to the Mayor and Councillors to seek council support in the sealing of Hopkins St, Aireys Inlet, between the Great Ocean Rd and Hartley St as a priority.

The roadway between the existing sealed intersections at Hartley St and Great Ocean Rd carries significant traffic throughout the year, at levels well in excess of council benchmarks to normally trigger road upgrade reviews. As the main feeder road to the north eastern Aireys Inlet precinct, the speed and increasing volume of cars along this unsealed section contributes to dust and rapid deterioration of the street, and safety issues to the popular pedestrian corridor.

As ratepayers/residents in the street, we seek support in sealing this portion of Hopkins St together with installing effective and appropriate speed reduction measures. The sealing should avoid creating a standard, suburban like streetscape, instead complimenting the natural environment in its design.

The portion of Hopkins St under review has 21 residences. A total of 13 residences were visited on a recent weekend, of which 11 were supportive of and recognised the need for urgent action; 1 was supportive of but undecided; and 1 was against. The proposal seeking urgent support therefore represents a majority of the directly impacted residences in Hopkins St between the Great Ocean Rd and Hartley St.

Hopkins St, Aireys Inlet (Great Ocean Rd to Hartley St)

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Hopkins St is a high traffic access road servicing the majority of the north eastern section of Aireys Inlet. By the councils own benchmarks, the current traffic volumes in Hopkins St significantly exceed the minimum traffic levels required to initiate road sealing works.

Any sealing of the road requires particular attention to maintaining the unique and natural aspect of the area. This may include non bituminous surfaces, but should introduce traffic calming measures to further encourage pedestrian street access, and particularly avoid creating a standard suburban type streetscape.

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
