Special Conditions of Use 2016 - Bells Beach Tour Operator Licence

Special Conditions:

Parking Conditions for Commercial Tour Vehicles:

- The Licensee of any commercial tour vehicle must park in the designated parking bays as per the notation on the attached plan showing Permit Zone 9am -11am Commercial Buses Only.
- If all designated parking bays are full the Licensee cannot stop within the reserve and must move on.
- The Licensee will keep a record of 'could not park' data from the operators and this data shall be provided to the Surf Coast Council to guide future decision making.
- The Licensee must not park anywhere else in the reserve except in the designated permit area.

General Tour Conditions

- The Licensee must ensure that individuals use the pedestrian crossing when walking to the lookouts or accessing the toilets.
- The Licensee must obtain agreement from the Licensor regarding the location and timing of tour activities so that conflicting programs between the Licensee and other users can be avoided.
- No rubbish may be left in the reserve. The Licensee must accept a 100% take in/take out policy including cigarette butts.
- Engines must be turned off as soon as practicable and loudspeakers may not be used while within the reserve. Vehicle horns may only be used for traffic safety purposes.
- The Licensee must clearly display a valid tour operator licence permit issued by the Licensor at all times for any vehicle entering the reserve.
- The Licensee must provide a short safety briefing to all passengers prior to exiting the bus to beware of cars, buses, surf conditions and to respect privacy of surfers.
- The Surf Coast Shire reserves the right to change the areas which tour operators may use, for any reason, including visitor safety and including events such as the 'Rip Curl Pro' surfing carnival and environmental reasons, without Surf Coast Shire being liable for the payment of any compensation for any such change to the licence conditions (into perpetuity).
