Family Day Care Service Review Implementation & Growth

Background

Family Day Care Service Review was endorsed by Council on 28 June 2016 Council, with resolution to:

- Increase the administration levy in a stage manner to fully recover all costs associated with the service
- Increase administration levy to \$1.40 as of 1 January 2017
- Actively pursue growth to contain the level of subsequent levy increases
- Provide an update to Council mid 2017 to recommend the setting of any subsequent levy increases.



Increase the administration levy to achieve cost neutrality

 Admin levy increased from 42cents/hour to \$1.40/hour on 1 January 2017



Actively pursue growth

A number of marketing & promotional activities have taken place:

- Advertisement in Surf Coast Times and on Facebook
- Recruitment flyers distributed around the municipality and at early years reference group services
- Recruitment information place in quarterly early years newsletter to families
- Hours of care provided to children has increase from 56,199 annually to 63,135, a 12% increase
- The number of children on the waitlist has decreased from 64 to 36 children



Actively pursue growth


The number of Educators has increased from 12 to 15 (plus a casual Educator) and this has also provided a greater reach across the Municipality:

Financial Cost Neutrality

- Have had some growth which has reduced the impact of further Admin Levy increases, but not removed the need for another increase
- Need a second Admin Levy increase of \$1.70 in January 2018 to achieve cost neutrality in 2017/18







2017/18 Budget Changes

2017/18 Budget Changes

- There was an oversight when the 2017/18 fees for Family Day Care service through Council's budget process that needs to be rectified:
 - Officers committed to return to Council with the outcome of the growth initiatives
 - At the time of proposing the 17/18 budget officers should have used the assumption of \$1.40 administration levy, until Council resolved differently
 - Officers incorrectly included a second increase in the adopted budget (\$1.70 listed in fees table)
- Officers have continued to charge \$1.40 and where not planning on charging a higher rate until further Council resolution following this mid-year review





Commonwealth Funding Changes

Additional Funding Changes

Community Support Program Funding (Federal)

- Advice that this will cease 30 June 2018 as a part of the Governments roll out of *Jobs for Families* initiative, which was not known at the time of the service review
- Community Support funding will only be available for identified vulnerable areas – which is not Surf Coast Shire
- Projected loss of \$40,728 in funding from 2018/19.



Implications of funding loss

Option 1 – full cost recovery by June 2019

An additional Admin levy increase in July 2018 to \$2.20.

Option 2 – full cost recovery by June 2020 (Preferred Option)

 A consistent, annual Admin levy increase over a further year. Council will need to subsidise the service in 2018/19.

Recommendations

It is recommended that Council adopt the following:

- Continue to increase the administration levy in a staged manner to fully recover all costs associated with the service
- Increase the levy to \$1.70 from 1 January 2018
- Continue to increase the levy annually, until cost neutrality is achieved by June 2020.
